Target group:

Target group of the project were unemployment youth in Gorski kotar, between 15 and 24 years old with no work experience, with a low level of qualifications and skills and also unemployment young people with college degree, up to age 29, as well as graduates of high schools.

- 50 young people educated
- 20 young people gained first work experience
- 100 high school graduates were informed about the opportunities of self – employment

Main objective: To reduce youth unemployment in mountainous, rural area of Croatia (Gorski kotar) for 5%.

Project activities: Training programs that raised the ability, skills and self-motivation of young people for employment and self-employment were held in order to achieve the main objective of the project. Besides that, unemployed, young people were given opportunity to gain first work experience in cooperation with local business entities.

Sub objectives: To create a plan that will encourage the employment of young people and establish the cooperation of all sectors in society in order to resolve the problems of unemployment young people in the future.
